	Complete a <i>Radio Check</i> before leaving
	• Know escape routes from ICP and in an emergency leave with Fire Personnel

•	Check if ICP is aware of any animals needing evacuations		
•	Report if NVADG has any Requests for Services and in what areas

	need to coordinate with Division Chief to enter.		
Thin	gs to Consider		
•	Remember everything said in ICP is CONFIDENTIAL!		
•			
•	Acquire three copies of the Incident Action Plans and QR Code. Maps (Send to		
	NVADG Dispatch, BCAC, and we keep a copy		
•	Listen for Flare Ups (Remember to be sure to announce over NVADG Frequency when near where Evac Teams are!)		
•	Follow what the Evac Teams are doing in the field		
•			
	Coordinate with the Cal Fire Liaison Officer as to the situation and resource needed		
•	If Butte County Sheriff Honea arrives at ICP, introduce yourself. Let him know		
	NVADG is there and working with whoever his onsite officer is.		
•	Acquire Wi-Fi Password if available (Sherriff or Search and Rescue Units usually		
	have one)		
•	WhatsApp Fire Group, post pertinent information (Contacts, Fire Info., etc.)		
•	The first 24 / 48 hours things are fluid. Initial Attack Plans are not written, yet
