Title: 2022 Fire Season Mileage Reimbursement

Objective: To provide a system where volunteers may get reimbursed directly from NVADG when Butte County has not authorized mileage reimbursement at an incident.

Description:

During a medium to extended size deployment, Butte County will usually offer mileage reimbursement to volunteers. However, on some short deployments that system sometimes does not get engaged. In that case, NVADG would like to provide mileage reimbursement directly to our volunteers. This is not an absolute, but will be the goal for the 2022 Fire Season.

- This SOG has a “Sunset Clause” terminating on December 31, 2022.
- Mileage will be reimbursed at \$.625 per mile.
- There will be no adjustments for EVs, or vehicles towing trailers.
- This is not mandatory; you do not have to request reimbursement.
- If Butte County authorizes mileage reimbursement for an event, NVADG will not provide any reimbursement.
- To apply:
 - Within 15 days of Demob, send the following to: NVADG, PO Box 441, Chico CA 95927
 - Paper copy of your ICS 214 with all destination and mileage documentation
 - NVADG Request for Mileage Reimbursement (attached)
 - The Butte County Mileage Reimbursement form will also be accepted
