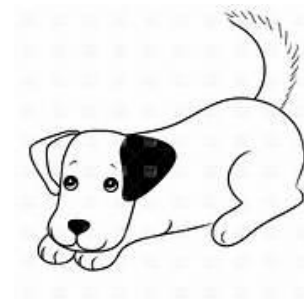


Feeding Dogs and Walking



Volunteer and Animal Safety is Priority
Work in Teams of Two

Morning:

- *NOTE: Feed all dogs a light meal the day of Intake.*
(Feed the dogs *after ALL* dogs in the room have been walked and the kennels cleaned!)
Mix in large feed tub: One canned dog food to six cans of dry dog food, and one can+ fresh water. Make as large a batch as necessary to feed the dogs in the room.
- Feed all dogs in a new paper food tray. Feed appropriate amount for the size of dog. (If health appears questionable, seek guidance from Dog Lead.)
 - Check for special needs food (will be noted on Care Sheet).
 - **Feed Twice a Day: Small (20 lbs.) ½ cup, Medium (20 – 40 lbs.) 1 cup, Large (40 – 70 lbs.) 1.5 cups, and Extra Large (70 + lbs.) 1.5 cups.**
 - Document everything on the Animal Care Schedule, use military time.
 - Remove paper food tray when finished.
- Walk all dogs approximately one hour after feeding.
 - Use an organized system to ensure no animal is missed.
 - Update Care Schedule.

Evening:

- Feed all dogs as described above.
 - Remove the paper food tray when finished.
- Walk all dogs as directed above.
 - Spot clean each kennel, as needed.

When Finished for the Evening:

- Double/Triple check to make sure all latches are secured and update any changes on the room whiteboard.
- Turn room lights off for Quiet Time.
